



REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS (RFP)
Provide Services to the Juvenile Realignment Population

The Lassen County Probation Department (“LCPD”) is requesting proposals (“RFP”) to provide wellness services to youth and families involved in the Juvenile Justice Systems in an effort to reduce incarceration rates of the eligible, realigned Division of Juvenile Justice (“DJJ”) minors in accordance to Senate Bill 823. These youth have been charged or adjudicated for a serious or violent felony and are in need of community-based services and programs to reduce co-dependency, address criminogenic needs, provide emotional support, anger management strategies, restore family structure, and reduce out-of-home placements and recidivism.
